Connecticut State authorized \$500,000 Construction Grant

Sherman Library awarded \$75,000 from private foundations and a \$100,000 THUD construction grant

2006 Redesigned library plan to reflect Sherman residents' feedback for an expansion the town would support

Capital campaign strategy developed

Enter quiet phase of capital campaign

Additional \$100,000 committed from private donations

2007 January Present revised plan to Board of Selectmen February-April Present plan to community

2007 June Town of Sherman voted to approve referendum of \$1,000,000 for library expansion project

2008 Fall 2009 Spring Present project plans to town commissions

2008 November Connecticut State authorized \$1,000,000 Construction Grant

2009/2010 Acquire necessary approvals and permits. Continue to work with engineers and architect. Continue with Capital Campaign to raise funds

2012 February 8 Petition submitted with 20 signatures to rescind Town Grant for library building project

2012 February 24 Town meeting to discuss the petition and vote to rescind the Town Grant. 130 attended majority support library.

2012 March 3. Referendum vote to rescind grant, 397-648 against, Library prevails
